Dear Hazel Lansdale,

Thank you for your reply of 14<sup>th</sup> January to my letter of 18<sup>th</sup> December. I found the statistics for the number of prisoners over tariff very interesting. However, in your response you say:

“There is no central record within NOMS of the number of prisoners beyond tariff and who are currently in the process of appealing against their conviction.”

In view of this response, I would like to ask:

1. What records **do** exist within the National Offender Management Service of prisoners who are appellants and at what level?
2. If records exist at some level (for instance at individual prisons, elsewhere in the Prison System or within the Probation Service), can you let me have these records collated and cross-referenced against the figures for prisoners over tariff?
